For this event, we need approximately 100 volunteers. (More is always better!)

Please understand that signups are first come, first served basis. Please indicate what area you would like to work in (set up, pourer, or main gate) on the back of this form.

Preferred shifts go early, so apply as soon as possible in order to receive the shift/area you want!

Please arrive at the Village Park at least 30 minutes before your start time of your shift. You will receive your volunteer swag and a short orientation covering procedures and duties prior to the start of your shift. (Those volunteering to be pourers are required to attend a class prior to the festival. You will be notified of the date and time.) Arriving early is important so shifts can start on time! If you do not show up for your scheduled volunteered time, you may not be able to volunteer at future events.

Water is available to volunteers during the event, at NO TIME IS ANY VOLUNTEER TO BE DRINKING DURING THEIR SCHEDULE SHIFT! Please be prepared to stand for the duration of your 3 hour shift.
